
Table 5: Operation of the Oregon Health Plan (OHP), 1994–1999

Absence of rationing

- No evidence of wide-scale service exclusion
- Physician noncompliance with rules

No rationing, no savings

- List has not generated substantial savings
- Expanded coverage funded not through rationing, but by general revenues and managed care

Health services technology

- Rankings primarily influenced by subjective judgements
- Rationing has not operated according to an objective formula

Expanded coverage

- State's uninsured rate significantly reduced
 - OHP has covered over 600 000 people
