7. Nature of Defect: According to Clause 8.2.3.1 of ISO 10161-1:1997 (E), the SHIPPED APDU, together with the RECEIVED, RETURNED and CHECKED-IN APDUs, are identified as optional messages. When the RECEIVED APDU ("RCV"), the RETURNED APDU ("RET") and the CHECKED-IN APDU ("CHK") appear as outgoing events in State Tables A5 and A7 of Annex A, each event is identified as being optional. However, in the cell formed at the intersection of the incoming event "SHIreq repeat" and the "SHIPPED" state in *Table A.7, Responder State Table - Tracking Phase*, the outgoing event is simply "SHI" with no indication that the event is optional.

8. Solution Proposed by the Source: Revise the cell formed at the intersection of the incoming event "SHIreq repeat" and the "SHIPPED" state in *Table A.7, Responder State Table - Tracking Phase*, to include annotation that the SHIPPED APDU is optional:
